Supervisor Khoury reported that Baillie has cleaned up the area where the logging was done in the forestry area belonging to the Town.

The third quarter sales tax has been received and had increased from the previous quarter.

Carrie Anderson was present to discuss her property and Junk Yard regulations. She obtained a Junkyard Application, which will be returned to the Town Board for review before the issuance of a Junkyard Permit. Mr. Palmiter moved to pass the resolution to be filed with the State of New York to give authority for obtaining Municipal Ambulance Operating Services, seconded by Mr. Hodge, Carried.

Mr. Powrie moved for the Town to hold a Public Hearing at the Town Hall on Sept. 14, 2021 at 8:00 P.M. for the purpose of discussing the adoption of Local Law No. 1 of 2021 entitled: "Opting out of allowing Retail Dispensaries and On-Site Consumption Sites for Cannabis within the Town of Smyrna, seconded by Mr. Palmiter, Carried.

Chenango County Health Dept. has been communicating about the possibility of a COVID vaccine clinic in our Town.

Mr. White reported that the Sutter subdivision has been completed. The Planning Board is still researching Solar and Wind projects.

Mr. Schraft moved for adjournment at 8:40 P.M., seconded by Mr. Palmiter, Carried.
